Notice of Termination (NOT) for General NPDES Permit

This form is required to be submitted when requesting termination of coverage from any General NPDES Permit, other than the General NPDES Permit for Stormwater Discharges from Construction Activities (termination requests for the CGP should be submitted using Form CN-1175), issued by TDEC. The purpose of this form is to notify TDEC that either all previously authorized discharges from the facility have ceased or have been eliminated; or you are no longer an operator at the permitted site. Submission of this form shall in no way relieve the permittee of permit obligations required prior to submission of this form. Please submit this form to Water.Permits@tn.gov. For the purposes of this certification, elimination of discharges means that all stormwater discharges associated with activities from the identified site that are authorized by a NPDES general permit have been eliminated from the portion of the site where the operator had control.				
I certify under penalty of law that this document and all attachments were prepared by me, or under my direction or supervision. The submitted information is to the best of my knowledge and belief, true, accurate, and complete. I am aware that there are significant penalties for submitting false information, including the possibility of fine and imprisonment.
